Seminars on Strategic Dialogues in 2018

Summary

The pension funds in Iran already encounter a number of complex and multidimensional problems, which have had impacts on the pension fund members in the past few decades. The complexities of the pension funds in terms of their activities, performance, and problems in different areas have affected the economic, social, and political dimensions of the society. As a result, the matter of management and leadership in the pension funds requires multidimensional knowledge and various types of expertise leading to the promotion of their performance. Besides, due to the social nature of the funds, the solutions ought to be proposed by the experts coming from various fields; therefore, addressing the problematic issues of the pension funds demands global and comprehensive social dialogues between and among the experts. Accordingly, SPSI has arranged seminars and included strategic dialogues in its agenda so that different aspects of the current problems can be discussed in detail and possible approaches can be introduced in this regard.
